But few stranger than this black plastic "monster" that surfaced at Sorrento today.

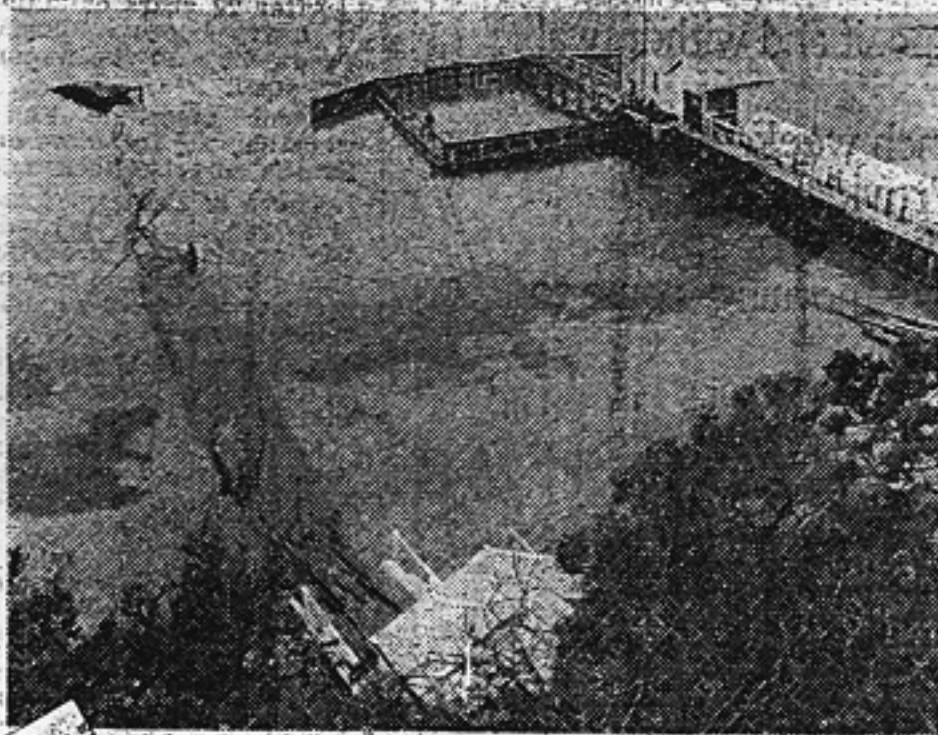
On closer inspection it proved to be a piece of "environmental sculpture."
